- Prohibited Items: food, liquids, explosive or flammable substances, hazardous materials, items that degrade over time and produce chemicals or other substances harmful to the other contents... there may be additional items added to this list.

Throughout the year:

- ___Newspaper front pages major headlines
- ____Sports trading cards (or other collectibles)
- ____A list of popular expressions (slang)
- ____A popular toy or doll (Beanie Babies®, etc.)
- ___Product packaging (empty Coke[®] can, etc.)
- ___An extended family tree
- ____A copy of a future-oriented magazine
- ___Your favorite magazine
- ___Items from your job or school
- _Year-in-review issues of magazines or Newspapers

___Treasured memories in the past year __Pricelist of everyday items (groceries, utilities, home & car prices, etc.

Preservation Tips:

- ___Place all organic (e.g. paper-based items) materials in 100-percent polyethylene bags (see archival supply distributor catalogs) or Mylar-D (pure polyester) film enclosures.
- Place special buffered acid-free, lignin-free interleaving tissue between posters, maps and other flat items in the same enclosure.
- Use unbuffered, acid-free, lignin-free papers to separate black-and-white photographs and protein-based materials, such as leather
- __Wrap textiles in Mylar-D and tie with
- neutral-colored cotton tape.
- ___Avoid wool, silk and nylon fabrics, because they could break down, giving off sulphur or other harmful gasses.
- __Place crumpled pieces of unbuffered acidfree, lignin-free paper in the folds of folded clothing items to reduce sharp creasing and broken threads.

Photographs should be archivally processed black-and white prints on fiberbased papers. Avoid placing newsprint in the capsule.Photocopy newspaper clippings onto archival quality (acid-free, lignin-free and buffered) paper and enclose them in Mylar-D envelopes. Do not laminate or drymount photographs.
